



CULTURAL CORNER

Tusen takk to Gayle Mathiesen and Amanda Saxton for organizing a Rosemaling Workshop with instructor Marilyn Hansen, October 3-5, 2025.

The three-day workshop was taught by professional rosemaler, Marilyn Hansen, from Bellevue, Washington. Marilyn is a member of the Western Rosemalers Association and teaches frequent classes throughout the Pacific Northwest. Her work has been exhibited in museums and private collections worldwide. Marilyn also happens to be a cousin of Gayle's mom, so we were glad to welcome her to our lodge!

16 students of all skill levels participated in the three full days of instruction. We learned how to make the basic C and S strokes that are the foundation of rosemaling, practiced brush control and techniques, mixed color palettes, practiced transferring and painting a design on cardboard, and eventually completed a handcrafted 8" wooden plate as our final painted class project. Some of us were skeptical about being able to complete the end

product in time, but Marilyn calmly and expertly walked us successfully through the process.

We'd like to express our deep appreciation to Marilyn and also to all of the students who brought food and snacks throughout the workshop. 
Book Donations

For those interested in Vikings, we've received quite a few new titles, including the following:




Vikings: The Battle at the End of Time by Tony Allan (2019)

Santa Lucia, or Saint Lucy's Day, is the church feast day dedicated to Saint Lucy and is observed on December 13. Its modern day celebration is generally associated with Sweden, Norway, Denmark and Finland. Santa Lucia comes as a young woman with lights and sweets, marking the return of longer daylight to winter darkness. It is one of the few saint days observed in Scandinavia.

At our program at the lodge, a procession is headed by one girl wearing a crown of candles (or lights), while others follow in the procession with girls holding a single candle and boys holding a star.

Children learn and sing Norwegian and Swedish songs, often accompanied by harp and piano. Families are treated to a talent show, singing around the Christmas tree, and enjoy authentic Scandinavian rice pudding, open-faced sandwiches, and desserts. Santa Claus makes a special appearance at this event and hands out goodies to all attending children.
