Join us in celebration of Norway's Constitution Day for a traditional parade on Monday, May 17th at 6 p.m. in downtown Anchorage.

We will meet outdoors at Delaney Park in the open space west of "N" Street on the north side of the Rose Garden between 9th and 10th Avenues.

We encourage you to wear your bunads or Norwegian sweaters and red and blue ribbons as we carry Norwegian flags and the Bernt Balchen Lodge banner around the block. We will have flags on hand - or bring your own.

A short program will precede the parade and hot dogs and ice cream will follow. We encourage all ages to share favorite 17 Mai memories.

If you missed the April Friluftsliv playing Kubb there will be another chance to join the fun on May 17. "Viking Chess" or **Kubb** is an outdoor game where the goal is to knock down the opponent team's Kubb blocks and win by knocking down the king. Each teammate gets a turn to throw a baton at the other team's blocks. The plan is to set up several Kubb games in the open area west of the Rose Garden after the parade.

At the time of this writing the Municipality of Anchorage has lifted outdoor gathering limitations, although masking and physical distancing requirements remain in place.
