Rosemaling Supply List

Anchorage area Rosemaling Class - typical supplies and vendors

ESSENTIAL SUPPLIES

(*We will have stuff to share.)

- *-Wax paper or disposable palette (If you have a palette w/lid bring it)
- masking tape
- *-newspaper
- palette knife
- pens, pencils, *Q -tips (for erasing), baggies
- Pink Soap or vaseline
- Brushes: #4 flat and #1 or #2 liner
- *-Odorless paint thinner (Lowe's or Home Depot). Put some in a small jar with lid
- Bring extra plastic containers with lids, bring stiff cardboard the size of pizza box
- *-Boiled linseed oil or Walnut Alkyd oil medium
- flat box to transport work-in-progress (Costco and Natural Pantry have some)
- *-Graphite paper in white or gray or/and carbon paper (We will have some to share)
- stylus (to trace rosemaling design)
- Rags or lint free towels,

ARTIST OIL PAINTS

(We will have paint to share, but bring yours if you have them) Titanium White, Burnt Umber, Cadmium Red Light, Yellow Ochre, Prussian Blue

OPTIONAL PAINTS

Alizarin Crimson, Burnt Sienna, Cadmium Yellow Medium, Ivory Black, Raw Umber, Venetian Red

OPTIONAL SUPPLIES

Ruler, Scissors, Tracing Paper, Pliers, Wipe-out tool, Hand Wipes, Hand Cleaner (with grit) or Lava Soap (green bar in red wrapper from O'Reilly Auto parts store, or Ace Hardware).
